#### **OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY**

The Sub-Fund, expressed in Euro, aims at increasing over time the value of the invested capital by mainly investing in stocks from issuers having their registered office or principal economic activity in a developed country in the Pacific area, other than Japan, mainly listed on an official stock exchange or dealt in on another regulated market of developed countries in the Pacific area, other than Japan. For example these countries are: Australia, Hong Kong, New Zealand and Singapore. The Sub-Fund may invest in China A-shares via the Shanghai-Hong Kong Stock Connect program which allows foreign investors to trade certain Shanghai Stock Exchange listed China A-Shares through Hong Kong based brokers.

The Sub-Fund may use financial derivative instruments not only for the purpose of risk hedging but also for investment purposes.
